Musical Theatre Pre-Professional & Competition Team Audition Dress Code & Regulations

Female Performers: Leotard, black jazz pants/ black dance shorts/ tights, hair neat off the face (ie: Bun, half up half down, ponytail.) Bring all dance shoes with you. If you are doing a private showcase with KTM you may change into your choice of outfit & hair style after the group auditions.

Male Performers: Solid color t-shirt (no logos), Black jazz pants/ black dance shorts. Bring all dance shoes with you. If you are doing a private showcase with KTM you may change into your choice of outfit.

All Performers: No jewelry (small earrings are fine.)

Audition Schedule

6:30pm: Check in

6:45-8:15pm: Closed auditions (vocal, acting, dance)

Promptness:

All performers must arrive from 8:30am-8:45am to check in, stretch, and prepare. Head shots and resumes must be passed in during checkin.

Interview

Each performer must interview with the Directors (Erika Frank & Sarah Flannagan) before the audition. Once registration is complete (due by May 15th) you will receive an interview time.

Closed Audition Process

There will be no public viewing of auditions. Students need to prepare a 1 minute monologue of their choice, vocal solo (no longer than 2 minutes/ may be accapella or with instrumental music), and will have a group dance audition. Solo music must be submitted at checkin on cd or ipod. No use of youtube to locate music.

Audition Requirements

- 1) Completion of audition registration
- 2) Headshot & Resume ages 11+
- 3) Proper audition dress code
- 4) Students must display strong work ethic, dedication, good sportsmanship, and adhere to the CSPA Code of Conduct
- 5) No food or drinks allowed in the dance room
- 6) Serious submissions only
- 7) Remember to have fun!
